The strokes are numbered 1 through 8. Stroke 1 is the vertical line of ギ, stroke 2 is the horizontal line, stroke 3 is the diagonal line, stroke 4 is the bottom curve, stroke 5 is the top curve, stroke 6 is the top dot, stroke 7 is the vowel character's main stroke, and stroke 8 is the vowel character's tail stroke.
